Photo ID Updates for 2025-26

We have reviewed the photo ID images used on examination cards and the Examiner search facility on our website. To ensure all photos are up to date, we kindly ask all examiners to upload a new photograph taken in 2024 or early 2025.

A new self-service feature will be introduced in the Examiner Community to make this process easy and convenient. Full instructions on image quality requirements and how to upload your photo will be provided. Please ensure your updated photo is submitted by 31 March 2025 in order to successfully re-register.

Fees for BSS Certifications and Registration

The BSS **Certification fee** for registration year 2025-26 will be: **£76 plus VAT**. The new price will apply to all Certification Reports made online after 23:45 hrs on 31 March 2025.

Examiners annual registration fee 2025-26 - £300 plus VAT.



Pro-active Quality Assurance Programme

Pro-active Quality Assurance Assessments are support processes, they provide an opportunity to have a two-way honest discussion about your BSS Examiner activity. They identify any areas that need some strengthening in technique or processes. Everyone gets the opportunity to seek help where you feel less confident and to make suggestions or give feedback about how the BSS support you through its information, training, materials and services.

New Field Assessment Programme starts in 2025-26

A new Quality Assurance Field Assessment (QAFA) programme will start rolling out in 2025-26. We all need to be aiming for consistent Examinations, and we understand that undertaking BSS Examinations is challenging and detailed. The Field Assessment is here to support you to deliver the high standards we all aspire to.

The QAFA will be conducted by a BSS Quality Assurance Assessor (QAA) so we can jointly evaluate your approach to Examinations.

The focus is on ensuring adherence to BSS requirements, following examination procedures correctly, and accurately documenting findings. It's also an opportunity to confirm that professional conduct is upheld throughout the process.

Not only will this be a chance to assess your Examination field craft skills, but it's also an opportunity for a face-toface with a BSS representative. You'll be able to ask questions, share feedback, and raise concerns you have about processes you believe could be improved. This collaborative approach ensures we continue to enhance the quality and integrity of the BSS together.

New QAA – Robert Burton

We are happy to advise Examiners that we have a new QAA joining us in the next few weeks. Robert is a marine consultant, surveyor and former BSS Examiner and has a solid understanding and context of the decisions you take. If you are contacted by Robert, we ask that you engage with him in a timely way.





Mandatory Training 2025-26

Gas Competency Update and Re-authorisation

It is five years since the last round of LPG training and assessments, and quality assurance in this area of activity is important to the Scheme. This training programme will take place during the early autumn of 2025-26.

All examiners will complete an online module and attend training and assessment at Evesham (South Worcester College Group) We are still putting the details together, though it is likely to be a two-day event.

It will run as efficiently and effectively as possible and the fees will reflect what it costs us to provide the programme – current indications are that the fees will be around \pounds 500 plus VAT for each session with 10 Examiners participating in each group. Continued authorisation during the year will be reliant on the successful completion of the programme and assessment.

BSS Examination Recording App Training

Although not yet confirmed, there are current plans to launch the App in a phased roll-out from this coming autumn. Some Examiners may therefore be invited to take up the App in the 2025-26 registration period.

Prior to being able to use the App during Examinations, all Examiners will be required to complete associated online training modules. At this time, it is estimated that the modules will take between 8 and 16 hours to complete. The modules will be charged purely on a delivery cost recovery rate, estimated at this time as being no more than \pounds 100 plus VAT.
